Lauren's presentation - **"The Road to Independence for the Visually Impaired"** - will explain the Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services which is within the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation. The mission of the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation is to assist Pennsylvanians who are blind and visually impaired to work and also maintain independent lives. The presentation will focus specifically on the Independent Living Program.
